#### **AWARDS FOR ACP MEMBERS**

The ACP celebrates its nonagintennial in 2017, and to mark the event the number of awards available has been increased. The following awards are available to ACP members in the forthcoming year. Full conditions for each of the awards are available on the ACP website [www.pathologists.org.uk](http://www.pathologists.org.uk) together with application forms where applicable.

#### **ACP Career Development Awards**

Three awards (one for every 30 years of the Association's existence) of up to £10,000 are available to fund these awards which are tenable in 2017. Awards are available for Consultants and Specialist Trainees who have been members of the ACP for at least 3 years to undertake further professional development, either in the UK or overseas, and will not be awarded retrospectively for periods of study which have already taken place.

**The closing date for applications is 30.06.2017. Successful applicants will be notified on 01.08.2017.**

#### **ACP Travel Fund Awards**

£7,000 is available to fund these awards during 2017, up to a maximum of £500 per application for a UK educational activity or, at the discretion of the Education Secretary, £1,000 for an overseas educational activity. (Members with 6 months or more membership can apply for an award of up to £500 and after 12 months membership, up to £1,000.) Preference is given to Trainees applying for funding to attend scientific conferences or undertaking educational activities overseas. It is not available for any purpose in the UK or Republic of Ireland unless application to other sources has been unsuccessful and will not be awarded retrospectively for periods of study which have already taken place.

**There is no closing date for applications, which can be submitted throughout the year.**

#### **ACP Research Award for Pathologists in Training**

The Association of Clinical Pathologists is keen to promote research undertaken by members who are at an early stage of their careers. The Council of the Association awards an annual prize of £500 for the best paper in any pathological discipline presented by a trainee member. Submissions are invited of written papers of interest to clinical pathologists

**The closing date for applications is 1 April 2017**

#### **AWARDS FOR NON MEMBERS**

#### **ACP Student Research Fund Awards**

£45,000 is available to support the living expenses of a student undertaking a BSc or BMedSci. Applications for project funding and applications to support a BSc / BMedSci for the 2016 calendar year will be considered. There are nine awards (for each decade of the Association's existence), each up to £5,000.

**The closing date for applications is 29.09.2017. Successful applicants will be notified on 01.11.2017.**

#### **ACP Incentive Prizes for junior doctors (pre-ST)**

These awards are available to any eligible junior doctor (that is prior to beginning Specialty Training, including F1 and F2 years) who submit work demonstrating the importance of pathology in the practice of medicine.

Applicants can be practising in Great Britain, Ireland (or overseas under the supervision of an ACP member).

Suitable submissions might be an audit project; an essay highlighting a particular aspect of pathology and its practice; a questionnaire based project or an outline of work done in helping in a research project. A maximum of five prizes, of up to £100 each, will be awarded annually for the best submissions.

**Entries for this prize must be submitted before 1 April 2017**
